The DfE have announced that all six of the reformed National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) will be fully funded! The <u>deadline to apply</u> for a February 2022 start is 17<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

Generate Teaching Hub is part of <u>Warrington Primary Academy Trust</u> and is the only designated Teaching School Hub for Halton, Warrington and Wigan as chosen by the <u>Department for Education</u>.



# **Specialist NPQs**

This term the DfE launched the revised National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) creating three specialist qualifications, each one is now FULLY FUNDED for state school teachers and is 12 months in length with 3 days training, online learning, coaching support and is completed with a formative assessment.



- NPQ for Leading Teaching (NPQLT)
   For those who are, or aspire to, lead teaching in a subject, year group, key stage or phase.
- NPQ for Leading Behaviour and Culture (NPQLBC)
   For those who are, or aspire to, lead behaviour and culture and/or pupil well-being.
- NPQ for Leading Teacher Development (NPQLTD)
   For those who are, or aspire to, lead the development of other teachers, e.g.
   Mentors of Trainee Teachers or Early Career Teachers.

# **Leadership NPQs**

This term the DfE revised the National Professional Qualifications (NPQs) with three reformed leadership qualifications, **each one is now FULLY FUNDED** for state school teachers and is 18 months in length with 4-6 days training, online learning, coaching support and is completed with a formative assessment.

- NPQ for Senior Leadership (NPQSL)
   For those who are, or aspire to be, senior leaders leading across a school.
- NPQ for Headship (NPQH)
   For those who are, or aspire to be, Headteachers leading across a whole school (additional personalised coaching can be provided to new Headteachers).
- NPQ for Executive Leadership (NPQEL)
   For those who are, or aspire to be, executive leaders with responsibility across more than one school.



# **Key Events and information**

- On 17<sup>th</sup> November Generate Teaching Hub is hosting a meeting of all Initial
