We are the Wigan Area Lead for Generate Teaching hub. Our role is central to the delivery of ECF and NPQ programmes across Wigan and to building local, sustainable partnerships.



Early Career Framewor<u>k</u>

Golborne continues to lead on the delivery of the **Early Career Framework (ECF)** across Wigan Local Authority. As we approach the end of another successful year our large cohort of over **200 ECTs and their mentors** are well underway with the final module of the academic year. We have an exciting event for all of our current ECTs in Wigan, taking place in July to celebrate their success in completing both year 1 and 2. Further information will be sent directly to our partner schools.

If you have ECTs currently registered with us, you should have already received communication about this.

Following the nationally approved programme provided by Teach First, our exceptional local school leaders facilitate annual programmes of training to our cohorts in year 1 and 2. We are currently organising the transition into Year 2 where ECTs will be assigned to subject specific cohorts. Mentors in Y2 will be joining a brand new cohort across Wigan.

New ECTs can be signed up now to both Year 1 and Year 2 programmes. There is no need to re-register current Year 1 ECTs for Year

however, if they have changed schools at the end of Year 1 your school MUST re-register them so that we know about them!

If you would like to register an ECT with us then the process is slightly different from previous due to the DfE portal being unavailable until later in July 2023. Please follow the guidelines to get registered at your earliest convenience:

- First register with Generate Teaching Hub <u>Register your ECT here</u>.
- Please use this alternative link if your school is not using the Generate Teaching Hub as the appropriate body Non AB registration form
- Once available use this link to register your ECT to the DfE portal. Remember this is only necessary for ALL Y1 ECTs and any Y2 ECTs who are new to your school for September 2023 <u>DfE ECT</u> Portal

2023 Guidance

If you do not currently use Generate Teaching Hub as your appropriate body then you can register here: Generate AB registration. It is

important to note that the DfE are changing the organisations who are designated to provide the appropriate body service to schools. In summary these are:

- From 1st September 2023, only Teaching School Hubs can register new ECTs for the Appropriate Body induction service.
- Local Authorities will be able to continue to offer an Appropriate Body service to ECTs already registered with them who started in post before 1st September 2023.
- 3. From 1st September 2024, all ECT registered with a Local Authority for their Appropriate Body Induction service will need to be transferred by their school to another provider. Generate Teaching Hub will from 1st September 2024 be the local provider able to offer Appropriate Body Induction services.

Once your ECTs are all registered, you will receive communication from Golborne High School about the cohort allocation, dates, times and locations of each seminar for the academic year for your ECTs.


Generate Teaching Hub
